- ✓ Hiking boots (with support & Vibram soles) must be broke-in. We recommend plastic boots (Scarpa or Koflack) with glacier socks. (We have extra glacier socks) Good leather boots are fine as well
- ✓ Hip boots if you do not wear plastic with glacier socks
- ✓ Lightweight pair of fast drying long johns (top and bottom)
- ✓ Hunting pants (only one for the hunt) We recommend synthetic fleece (light weight for August and heavier for September
- ✓ Shirt long sleeve (quick drying synthetic or fleece, not cotton)
- √ Fleece sweatshirt or equivalent
- √ Warm lightweight coat down or light weight synthetic
- ✓ Lightweight rain gear (no ponchos). We use a ¾ length parka for a coat and glacier socks as bottom
- ✓ Extra socks thin and thick pairs 4 pairs
- √ Warm hat that covers your ears
- ✓ Lightweight fleece gloves
- √ Handkerchief
- ✓ Sleeping bag warm and lightweight with a compression sack
- ✓ Sleeping pad lightweight or rigid grooved.
- ✓ Back pack external frame that will carry all of your food, gear and sheep meat (we have extras). Expect loads from 60 to 80 pounds. We recommend hiking with 45 to 50 pounds up and down inclines with your boots. If you're a flatlander long staircases work as well
- ✓ Rifle and 2 boxes of shells
- ✓ Knife
- ✓ Binoculars (I prefer small ones 10x25s. They are light and low light is not a factor.)
- ✓ Camera and film
- ✓ Moleskin
- ✓ Lightweight flashlight or head lamp
- ✓ Toothbrush
- √ walking stick
- ✓ Light weight water proof bags
- ✓ Optional 2 1qt. bottles, range finder, lightweight waterproof bags
- ✓ Head Net if spring bear hunting.

If there is something you don't have, let us know. No need to go out and buy new gear if you have hunting clothes you are used to. If you want to look at new gear, I like KUIU clothing.
